**PGY1 = two 2-week rotations**

***PGY1 Block #1 – 2 weeks:***

*Initial Meeting/Community Meeting:* Meet with Community Faculty on first scheduled day of CHPT block time as coordinated by Community Liaison (CL)

\*\*Block times will essentially mirror each other; 2 intern groups will visit “rural” locations and 2 groups will visit “urban” locations during this Block time. During Block #2 groups will swap and visit the opposite location from Block #1.

*Community Faculty Expectations:*

- Orient resident to their program and community
- Provide immersion opportunities for residents into the culture/life of the community
- Assist residents in completing workbook activities (*My ABCD Assets; Community Asset Map; Windshield Survey; A Day in the Life; Reflection & Application*)
- Debrief time with residents

*Resident Expectations:*

- Complete assigned reading materials (chp. 1 in *Resident Project Workbook*) before block time – workbook activities will be completed during your block time with the support of your Community Faculty
- Arrive at Community Faculty’s location on time and with *Resident Project Workbook* (workbook can be found on CRC)
- Complete workbook activities/pages 1-18 during this block time (pgs. 19-21 will be completed at the conclusion of PGY1)

*Rotation Work Products:*

- Activities on pgs. 1-18 including: *My ABCD Assets; Community Asset Map; Windshield Survey; A Day in the Life; Reflection & Application*
- Make sure to jot down your thoughts/ideas in the *Daily Journal* on pgs. 22 & 23!

*De-Brief Meeting:* Bring completed workbook activities and be prepared to present on your community to all Intern groups
